## Guitar Hero II (PS2) Advanced Tournament Rules

This is an all-ages tournament; however, any participant under age 18 must be entered by a parent or legal guardian. Entry fee is \$10.00, which will be collected at time of signup.

### Tournament Set-up and Guidelines:

The tournament will be setup in a 1 vs. 1 pro face-off mode, double-elimination format with single-song rounds. The “winner”, or player with the **higher score** will advance to the next round. Ties will be resolved by highest percentage, then by note streak if required.

The song for each round will be chosen at random from a list consisting of all songs except for Bonus Songs and “Freebird”. **Song difficulty will be set to Hard during the first two rounds and then Expert for the remainder of the tournament.** Players verbally agreeing (in front of one or more witnesses, including a G.U. Staff member) to playing a particular song may forego the random selection, and select any song from the standard or Bonus Song list (except for “Freebird”). The “Hyperspeed” code cannot be used unless **both** players competing in a particular round consent to it; hyperspeed will be off by default.

Tournament seeding will be determined at random by the tournament organizers after registration has closed.

Tournament will be double-elimination; however, any entrant may “re-buy” into the tournament once after they have been eliminated for a re-entry fee of \$5 whereupon they will be given a “third” elimination before they are out of the competition. Free play will be available after the completion of the tournament.

All participants must register before the tournament by registering online and by coming in-person to the Gamer’s University registration desk at least 15 minutes prior to the tournament’s scheduled start-time and filling out the sign-up sheet.

There will be guitar controllers available for use at the tournament. Participants are welcome to bring their own guitar controllers for use in the tournament, but they are subject to prior approval by event organizers before they are used in competition.

The Point of this Tournament is to have FUN! Any participants or spectator causing problems or damage to equipment may be disqualified and asked to leave.

Tournament Rules and Prizes are subject to change based on the number of tournament participants, time constraints, and any other conditions that Gamer’s University staff recognizes as revision-worthy. Participation in this and any Gamer’s University competition is **at your own risk**; participation does not guarantee compensation of any kind (except prize-winners); participants may be photographed during events with or without notice, credit, or compensation.

Signature of tournament sign-up sheet and/or online prepayment of tournament entry signifies your legal receipt, acknowledgement, and acceptance of the above rules. If you have any questions, please ask a Gamer's University team member before signing.
